

Toilets are brilliant! The three Ps

Don't use the loo as a bin!

- If you put something into a toilet bowl and press the handle or button and it disappears then, in effect, it is 'flushable'.
- So what we really want to ask is: what products, often flushed down the loo, lead to problems in the drains or sewers or at the sewage treatment plant?

- Wet wipes are often flushed down loos. This is a really bad idea as, unlike poo or loo paper they do not break down and so block drains and sewers. If they get as far as the sewage treatment plant they block the machinery there.as well. What a nightmare!
